ORDINANCE NO. 940

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES AND PROVIDING ASSESSMENT, EQUALIZATION AND COLLECTION.

The City Council of the City of Hebron Estates, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That an Ad Valorem tax of \$ 0.161 on each \$100.00 of value of all real property taxable for municipal purposes except property assessed by the State, in said City, is hereby levied for the year 1994.

SECTION II: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees, for the repair and maintenance of streets and public ways and public buildings in said City, to pay for lighting City streets, and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the City.

SECTION III: That the assessment made by the Bullitt County Tax Commissioner for State and County purposes for 1994 shall be and is hereby adopted as the assessment for the City purposes, and the city tax book shall be made from the County list and the Tax Commissioner's books after they have been supervised and corrected by the County Board of Equalization.

SECTION IV: The City Clerk shall take the list of all persons subject to City taxation, who are not shown on the County Tax Commissioner's books, shall list all property, a portion of which is in City where the value of the portion in the City is not shown on Tax Commissioner's books.

SECTION V:

The City Clerk be and she is hereby directed to prepare tax bills for all persons and organizations in the City of Hebron Estates, Bullitt County, Kentucky, against whom taxes have been levied, and she is hereby directed to notify such person and organizations by mail that on January 2, 1995, any tax bill remaining unpaid will be declared delinquent.

SECTION VI: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be received by the City Clerk/Treasurer, at the Business Office of the City of Hebron Estates.

SECTION VII: Taxes shall be due and payable at the time set for the due date of the State and County Taxes. Taxes paid during 2nd month preceding due date shall be discounted discounted.

mark all unpaid tax bills in red ink **DELINQUENT** and add a penalty of Ten Percent (10%), as provided herein and report to the City Council the number of unpaid bills and the amount thereof; the Mayor will check all tax bills and correct errors, if any, and deliver the tax books back to the Clerk, who will proceed with the collection of all delinquent taxes, penalty and interest, and will report to the City Council at its regular meeting each month.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION IX:}}$ The Clerk is directed to advertise the above as provided by law.
