

**ORDINANCE NO. 2008-01**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO REZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LYING WITHIN THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The recommendation of approval made by the Bullitt County Planning Commission concerning the rezoning request of the Michael C. Idle and Keli A. Idle from (A) Agricultural to (R-1) Residential is approved for the property described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone in line of Shelbourne Deed Book 99, Page 116 formerly Bridges and the northwest corner of Torstadt and running thence with lien of Shelbourne South 89 3/4 East 330 feet to a stone corner to the tract conveyed to Girl Scouts Deed Book 78 Page 559; thence with line of the same South 5 West 723 feet, more or less, to the north right of way line of Hebron Lane, to be widened to 40 feet, Deed Book 104 Page 206; thence with the new right of way line North 82 1/2 West 243 feet, more or less; North 38 1/2 West 78 feet more or less; North 5 East 492 feet, more or less; North 1 1/2 West 85 feet; thence leaving the right of way North 18 1/4 West 57 feet to the beginning, containing 4.62 acres, more or less.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

SECTION THREE: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.


SECTION FOUR: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
